



Lithuanian Philatelic Exhibition KAUNAS-2015 Regulations

1. The exhibition Kaunas-2015 is a national philatelic exhibition organized by the Union of Lithuanian Philatelists – Lietuvos Filatelistų Sąjunga (LFS).
2. The exhibition will be held from November 19–22, 2015 at the Vytautas Magnus University, Daukanto g. 28, LT-44246, Kaunas, Lithuania.
3. The Kaunas-2015 Exhibition will be governed by the General Regulations (GREV) and the Special Regulations (SREV) of the FIP for the Evaluation of Competitive Exhibits.
4. Participation is open to all collectors who are members of LFS and youth collectors. The Organizing Committee can accept applications from foreign philatelists only if their exhibits content is related to Lithuania. The entrant must be the owner of the exhibit displayed.
5. Exhibits must comply with the regulations of the Philatelic Exhibition.
6. Application for participation at the Exhibition must be submitted until July 1, 2015.
7. The Organizing Committee informs applicants by July 15, 2015 whether their application is to be accepted or rejected.
8. Competitive Classes:
 - 8.1 Traditional Philately
 - 8.2 Thematic Philately
 - 8.3 Postal History
 - 8.4 Philatelic Literature
 - 8.5 Single Frame
 - 8.6 Youth Philately
9. All exhibits must be mounted on white pages and each sheet must be placed in a transparent protective cover. The sheets should be numbered consecutively, at the

front bottom right hand corner. Exhibitor's name and address should be written on the back of each sheet. The exhibit must be accompanied by two copies of the inventory.

10. Exhibits can only be submitted and withdrawn in person. On the closing day, collections will be returned within three hours after the exhibition closes.

11. Exhibits will be judged by the Jury, which is appointed by the LFS Board.

12. Exhibits in the Competitive Classes will be judged in accordance with the principles laid down in the GREV and SREVs.

13. The Jury will allocate awards and special prizes in accordance with Article 8 of the GREX. Donated prizes, which have been accepted by the Organizing Committee, will be placed at the disposal of the Jury to additionally recognize the best exhibits.
